NOTIFICATION

The documents to be submitted to the Immovable Property Commission upon application are specially arranged under sub-paragraph 5 of Article 3 of the 2006 Immovable Property Commission Regulations made under Articles 8(2)(A) and 22 of the Law no 67/2005 on the Compensation, Exchange and Restitution of the Immovable Properties, which are under the scope of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 1 of Article 159 of the Constitution. That is:


- a) In case of immovable properties, the Applicant submits a duly certified copy of his/her identity card and/or passport, the originals or copies or photocopies of the documents, duly certified by a certifying officer, showing the land registration references (title-deeds) of the claimed property, his/her shares in the respective property and that s/he is still the rightful owner of the property in question.
- b) In case of movable properties/chattels the Applicant submits;
 - (i) Originals or copies or photocopies of the documents, duly certified by a certifying officer, proving that the respective movable property had been purchased prior to 13 February 1975 such as receipts, cheques, bank transfer, foreign exchange transfer documents or vouchers to demonstrate that the respective amount is paid.



- (ii) In case of the transfer of the movable property/ chattel to the Applicant by way of inheritance, donation and/or gift, the originals or copies or photocopies of the documents, duly certified by a certifying officer, that is issued from the records kept by an official department and/or a natural or legal entity, proving that the respective transfer had been effected before 13 February 1975.

Based on the above-mentioned arrangements, at the time of the initial application any documents and/or records that are outside the scope of the aforementioned special arrangement shall not be submitted. However, they will be submitted at the direction meeting stage where all parties will be present. On the date of direction meeting, the parties shall notify the Commission, in writing and in the form of a list, about the documents that they will submit and/or the documents that they will request the other party to submit, if any. This list then will be delivered to the parties after being certified by the Commission.

In the light of the aforesaid, this document is kindly submitted for appropriate action.
